1. Update on Olsen Hall Incident

- a. On November 24, 2014, students occupied Olsen Hall. One male student verbally abused 3 female students, who filed a complaint.
 - i. Student Judicial Affairs is investigating the incident.
 - ii. The Chancellor and Provost plan to release a statement on the importance of acceptance and diversity on campus.

2. The Pantry- a food closet for UC Davis student

3. Fundraising Update
