February Discussion Highlights:

1. EnvisionUCDavis online game

- a. Gary Sandy introduced Rachel Hatch, Research Director for Institute For The Future (IFTF).
- b. Hatch described the background and purpose of the game. The game is scheduled to be held on February 24 and 25th for a continuous 36-hour period. Everyone is encouraged to participate.
- c. Input gathered from the game will be used in the University of the 21st Century initiative report to the Regents.
- d. An analysis of the game results will be conducted and reported on in March.

2. Hate Crime on campus

- a. Emily Prieto reported on a hate crime which occurred on the west side of campus. Arrests were made and the crime continues to be investigated.
- b. Discussion ensued primarily around how to create a safer environment on campus where people of color feel secure. More specifically the committee talked about how to make genuine advances in the push to further diversify campus and to hire and promote more African American faculty and staff.
- c. Chancellor Katehi expressed frustration with the slow pace of change and asked the group what more could be done.
- d. It was decided to focus the March CCC discussion on how to achieve real results and make progress.
