Discussion Highlights:

1. Feedback on December 9th Student Forum on Campus Climate

a. On December 9, 2013 leaders from student organizations and administrators met to discuss what the UC Davis community can and should do to improve campus climate.

i. Discussion Highlights

1. Students are reporting discrimination on campus as well as in the classroom.
2. Discrimination is not student-centric. Staff/faculty are also affected.
3. The student climate is ever-changing and we need to find ways to address diversity and discrimination. Suggestions included:
 - a. Developing a safe process for community members to report incidents of intolerance/discrimination.
 - b. Creating educational courses designed for Faculty and TAs to address cultural sensitivity issues in the classroom.
 - c. Designing a series of events to gather community members and encourage discussions around campus climate issues.
 - d. Exploring the idea of an Academic Ombudsman to address student concerns.
 - e. Creating an easily accessible, structured network inclusive of the existing resources already available on campus.

2. Campus Security and Video Camera Policy

- b. Any camera installed on campus for security would fall under this policy.
